Hello DPSCD Families:

Here's a list of food banks and free food pantries in Detroit and in Wayne County and distribution centers that provide a variety of resources to offer support to families in the region. Dozens of locations across all of Wayne County provide free food near you, hot meals, paper products, baby formula, and much more. There are even soup kitchens scattered across the city as well as the county, and every year tens of thousands of families turn to the centers for help.

The food banks of course provide household basics such as free food, groceries, produce, frozen items, breads, personal and feminine hygiene supplies, and several other services. However, there are also staff that direct qualified low-income families to everything from emergency SNAP, food stamp, and WIC applications to Meals on Wheels programs. Some centers even can provide free meals at Christmas or Thanksgiving, as well as holiday gifts for children.

In addition, while not as well known, a food bank is a great place to call or stop by to learn about other assistance programs that may be available. For example, you can learn about both state of Michigan and federal government benefit programs and referrals are also given to other locations in Wayne County that offer food or other assistance, including financial assistance, locations that provide clothing, or get help in applying for food stamps, Snap or WIC. The food pantries in Detroit and Wayne County provides extensive assistance that is available and always free of charge.
